

Philosophy Statement

Chiropractor and staff employed by Rainville Chiropractic Professional Corporation promote foot health by creating personalized medical foot health treatment plans. As Chiropractor, we are licensed health care professionals trained in the prevention, assessment, educating and treatment of foot-related conditions by means of therapeutic, surgical, orthotic and palliative models/approaches.

The Mission:

The mission is to improve both the individuals' quality of life and foot health by providing the knowledge and the tools necessary to facilitate and effectively implement a treatment plan that will satisfy both the client's and foot health needs.

The Values:

Consultations: We believe that each individual has the right to a timely, accessible, safe and salubrious clinical environment in order to be comprehensively assessed. All presenting foot health condition must be evaluated, treated by our professional staff within the scope of our Chiropractic practice.

Accountability and Responsibility: We believe it is both necessary and beneficial to hold each individual client accountable and responsible for their foot health behavior, and to support this, we provide professional foot health care management services. Furthermore, each client is then educated on their respective presenting foot related condition and treatment plan is therefore recommended. It is imperative that each client is actively involved in the development of their respective treatment plan process thereby having the client actively make a better informed choice regarding their foot care and foot health. We firmly believe that a salubrious and professional clinical environment will result in a more favorable and increased awareness, compliance and quality of life for both our clientele and staff members, respectively.

Recognition of Needs: We recognize that each individual has basic human needs that must be met and satisfied. However, more often than not, some particular presenting foot related conditions may not be directly associated to a physical anomaly but rather to a physical symptom stemming from the individual's personal and psychosocial environment. In order to properly address these particular needs, our foot care teamwork service system is designed to recommend specific referrals to our clients to other trained professional in the community. Therefore, our staff professionals may effectively evaluate and treat the client's biomechanical anomalies according to the standards and scope of our Chiropractic Practice.

Sensitivity: We firmly believe that a client's physical and mental health is inextricably bound together to form a comprehensive and unique individual. Therefore, our

professional recommendations and treatment plan must reflect the current lifestyle, physical and mental ability of each respective client.

The Validity: of Rainville Chiropody Corporation is recognized merely by our strict compliance and adherence to the Standards and Practice of the College of Chiropodist in addition to the promotion of our mission statement, values and service framework as stated within the Rainville Chiropody Corporation Philosophy Document.

Access to Services: We believe that our foot care team work service system' is allied with other health professional with the community and due to this service access feature we ensure the success of our clients overall treatment and foot health care management plans.

The Co-Ordination of Services: We believe that having the professional and staff members of our organization openly accept and mindfully conduct themselves (both personally and professionally) according to the Philosophy Document of Rainville Chiropody Professional Corporation, We are able to deliver our professional foot care services with a level of quality, consistency and uniformity to be rightfully expected by each individual client. Rainville Chiropractic Professional Corporation's Code of Ethics

1. As a member of RCPC staff or board of directors, I will place the welfare of each individual person and their family in matter affecting them above all other concerns.
2. To this end, I will deliver kind and humane treatment to all in my care regardless of race, creed age or sexual preference
3. I will not deliberately do harm to any individual person, either physically or psychologically. I will not verbally assault, ridicule attempt to subjugate or endanger any individual person, nor will I allow other individual person or RPCP staff to do so.
4. I will encourage changes in the lives of each individual person only on their behalf and in the interest of promoting foot health, education, healing from within the scope of practice of a Chiropractor. I will not otherwise press individual persons to adopt beliefs and behavior's which reflect either unhealthy disposition or my value system rather than their own.
5. I will remain aware of my own skills and limitations. Since individual persons and former clients perceive me as a person of authority and hence overvalue my opinions, I will attempt never to advise them on matters not within my area of expertise. I will recognize when it is in the best interest of the patient's of RCPC to be referred or discharged to another health care provider.
6. I will not engage in any activity that could be construed as exploitation of any individual person for personal gain, be it sexual, financial or social.
7. I will not attempt to use my authority over any individual person in a coercive manner to meet my own ends. I will not promote dependency, but rather assist each individual to understand and manage his or her foot health.
8. I will not name or give information about any active or inactive clients (and family members) of RCPC except to other RCPC staff as required for assistance or when specifically authorized in writing by the individual client themselves.
9. I understand and agree to defend both the spirit and the philosophy of RCPC's mission, value and service provisions, and to respect the rights and views of other professionals.
10. As a health care provider, I understand that a therapeutic relationship does not end with the completion of the intended management plan. Any relationships with

former clients of RCPC is bound to the same conduct stated wherein the Philosophy document.

11. I will exhibit responsible concern for the well being of my peers and RCPC community by not ignoring manifestations of unhealthy or unethical conduct in other colleagues.
12. I will accept, by my own volition, the responsibility for my continued professional and personal growth and development as a part of my commitment to providing quality care for those who seek my assistance.
